RULES

- 1. No person shall enter more than three entries for any one species category during a program year, to include no more than one entry for kept fish and two entries for catch and release of the same species.
- 2. Any legal angler is eligible (whether resident or non-resident).
- 3. Fish shall be hooked and landed or hooked, boated, and landed in the State of New Hampshire by the entrant during the legal open season for the species taken.
- 4. Any species of fish shall be eligible for the State Record Fish program.
- 5. Weigh the fish as soon as possible on scales certified by the NH Division of Weights and Measures. Two witnesses must be present and both must sign the official entry form. Submit the printed weight slip with your entry form. (Do not freeze the fish before certifying weight as this will reduce the weight.)
- 6. Before the entry form can be accepted, the truth of statement must be attested to by a qualified officer such as a notary public, justice of the peace, town clerk, postmaster, state or local law enforcement officer, or Fish and Game employee, including their title and telephone number.
- The Department reserves the right to question any witness, examine the scales used for weighing any entry, or refuse any incomplete application.
- 8. All entries shall be submitted on official entry forms provided by the Department. These forms shall be available at any NH Fish and Game office or online at: https://www.wildlife.state.nh.us/fishing/trophy.html
- 9. A clear side view photo must be submitted with all applications. Catch and Release fish shall be photographed at the site of catch. If the fish shows any signs of improper handling prior to release, it shall be disqualified. (Photographs can be submitted via email to: reg2@wildlife.nh.gov Your photos will be joined with your official entry form upon receipt. All entry forms must have original signatures and should be mailed to NH Fish and Game Region 2, PO Box 417, New Hampton, NH 03256-0417).
- 10. The program runs January 1 through December 31 each year. Complete applications must be received within 30 days from the date of landing the fish. No entries will be accepted later than January 30 for the prior year. Winners will be notified by February 15.
